I pledge to have and show a positive attitude and be responsible during my participation in Coastal FC by abiding by the following codes of conduct:

- 2. I realize that I have a responsibility as a member of a team sport and will do my best to support the team throughout the season. I will always try my best.

- 6. If I disagree with a coaching or team staff decision I will speak to my parents who may act on my behalf or I will speak to the coach or team staff directly to express my views in a respectful manner.
- 7. I deserve to have fun during my soccer season and will alert parents or coaches if it stops being fun or an enjoyable experience.
- 8. I deserve to play in an alcohol, drug and smoke free environment and expect all participants to respect my wishes.
- 9. I will refrain from using drugs or alcohol prior to all games and practices.
- 10. I will encourage my parents to be involved and support my team and me in some capacity, as it is important to me.
- 11. I will always try to be on time for games and practices.
- 12. I will remember that soccer is an opportunity to learn and to have fun.



- 13. I will agree to refrain from foul language, taunting, and talking disrespectfully.
- 14. I will not accept or participate in bullying of any player physically, verbally and emotionally.
- 15. I acknowledge that all persons and especially children and young people have a right to be protected from abuse regardless of their age, gender, disability, culture, language, racial origin, religious beliefs or sexual orientation.
- 16. Failure to comply with the above may result in my temporary or permanent suspension of playing privileges.
